Solo or team motorcycle routes in the Swiss Alpine passes

Rules of the event

- 1) The Virée Alpine Suisse is not a speed test, the goal is to discover our country, the participants will receive a roadmap to fill in along the route, as proof of visit to the different crossing points.
- 2) Possibility to participate alone or in a team, departure every 2 minutes
- 3) The organizer is Thierry Quinche, Andains 14, 2340 Le Noirmont, tquinche@yahoo.com
- 4) Participants must comply with the Swiss Highway Code
- 5) By registering, the person acknowledges that he/she is able and has sufficient experience to consider participating in this event, which takes place mainly in an alpine environment, and releases the organizer from any responsibility.
- 6) Each participant holds the driver's license corresponding to the machine he/she is riding, valid at the time of the ride.
- 7) The tour is open to motor vehicles, 2 and 3 wheels, in accordance with the Road Traffic Act.
- 8) Vehicles will be examined before departure, the organizer may refuse the start to a vehicle, or its owner, if one of the 2 does not seem fit to do the proposed route.
- 9) Each candidate will be required to sign a waiver of liability to the organizer.

Registration

For the 2-day participation in the TWC event, registration will be done on the FMS website, www.swissmoto.org/fr/tourisme/calendrier-de-tourisme, for the other variants it is also possible to register on site with the organizer, at the Hotel Bären in Ringgenberg.

Registration Finance

The amount of the registration fee is 50 ChF (55 Euros) per participant, to be paid to the following account: IBAN CH51 8080 8001 0650 1097 7 mention: 2ème Virée Alpine Suisse.

Registration deadline

For the TWC event, registration will close on July 30, 2024, or earlier if the possible limit of participants is reached.

Team Composition

It is possible to participate alone or in a team, each team must have at least 2 motorcycles, trikes or sidecars, with or without a passenger.

Navigational aid

Participants can use their navigation aids, they will receive the coordinates of the waypoints, in order to be able to travel the 2 proposed routes.

Tracking the route

Participants will receive a booklet, to be clocked in at the various checkpoints, which will allow them to check if the route has been completed correctly and completely. This booklet will be used to decide between the participants in the event of a tie.

The route will consist of 2 loops, 1 Saturday and 1 Sunday, the participants will have to pass at the start/finish point, in order to validate the booklet of the tour made.

Refreshments/breaks

Refuelling is strictly the responsibility of the participants, they are responsible for managing their travel time.

Accommodation

Room reservations for participants are not the responsibility of the organization

Special conditions will be possible for a limited number of rooms, but at the expense of the participants. Participants are responsible for their own reservation.

A list of available accommodation in and around Ringgenberg will be made available on the website.

Responsibility

Everyone participates in the event under their own responsibility. Each participant is responsible for his/her own insurance coverage. By registering, each participant confirms that he/she is validly insured against accidents and civil liability damages. Participants cannot hold the organization responsible for their mistake. The organization may terminate, or cancel the event, in the event of force majeure, or danger jeopardizing the existence of the participants, without being held liable. Participants will not be able to claim compensation in the event of cancellation.

Regulation

The organization may amend these rules at any time in order to adapt them to a change in circumstances. These possible changes will be reported on the website, and communicated to those already registered, either before the event or directly on site during the event.
