FIM MOTOCAMP 2023 – SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Reg. 1

The 40th FIM Motocamp is organised by Forever Free Motorcycle Club (hereafter known as Organisers) on behalf of the LMSF (Lithuanian Motorcycle Sport Federation).

The event will be held from **03**rd **to 06**th **of August 2023** according to: the FIM Code for Touristic Gatherings (hereafter known as CTG); the FIM regulations; the FIM Environmental Code FMNR Regulations; the FMNR Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations.

For those wishing to arrive early, the camp site will be open from 1st August, at additional cost (Reg. 7).

The first meeting of the Executive Committee will be held on the 03 August 2023 at 17:00h in the Breakfast hall.









This meeting is only for the Executive Committee members and the CTL members – this meeting is not for National Delegates.

Subsequent meetings with National Delegates will be fixed by the Executive Committee on the site and will take place at the Breakfast hall.

Reg. 2 Participation in the Motocamp

According to Reg. 2.2 of the General Part of CTG and Reg. 2 from 1.2 category of CTG. The number of participants is limited to **400**. Registrations will be accepted according to the principle "first come, first served", upon verification of data and funds transfer received.

Reg. 3 Entries

Reg. 3.1

Individual entries will be made on the form available for this purpose (or the duplicate) which will be delivered to the FMNs by the Organiser (Art. 3 of the category 1.2 of the CTG) The FMNs should return completed entry forms to the Organiser after verification (verify entries, sign, stamp) - see address in Reg.1.1.

Individual participants (not affiliated to FMNs) should send their forms through their FMNs or directly to Organisers, depending on the decision of their FMNs.

Reg. 3.2

The FMNs will also add a summary list of the members entered; the sum paid for the entry fee and for the accommodation – camping in accordance with Reg. 7. Summary list format is going to be delivered to the FMNs by the Organiser.

Reg. 4 Entry Fee

The entry fee is fixed by the Federation (FMN) of the participant. This is composed of the Organiser's fee of **179 Euros** (€) plus any administrative expenses which may be added by the FMN of the participant. The amount is fixed in Euros (€) or the equivalent in local currency.

Children between the ages of 8 and 12 will pay 50% of an adult registration fee. Children under the age of 8 will be admitted free of charge.









The entry fee will be paid in full (100%) before **30. April 2023.** to the following account:

The payment will be done:

- For riders affiliated to FMNs
 - by participants FMNs
- For riders not affiliated to their FMNs
 - by participants FMNs, or directly to Organisers, depending on the decision of the participants FMNs

All payments will be made in Euros (€). The transfer costs are to be paid by the expeditor.

The Organiser is not obligated to accept entries after the closing date for entries, nor the entries made at the venue of the meeting.

- If the Organiser should accept entries after the closing date for entries, a surcharge of up to 25% to the entry fee may be imposed. Vacancy check prior to sending late entries is advised.
- If the Organiser should accept entries made at the venue of the meeting, a surcharge of 25% will be imposed. Vacancy check prior to arrival is advised.

Reg. 5 Closing dates

Entry deadline for registration and additional accommodation is 30. April 2023.

Reg. 6 Gifts, souvenirs and services for participants

Participant who has paid the entry fee through FMNs receives the minimal benefits:

- Participation in the FIM Motocamp
- Accommodation on a camping site for the duration of the event (from 03 August 2023 to 06 August 2023) - 3 nights
- 3 evening meals
- 3 breakfasts and 2 lunches
- Excursion and Parade of Nations
- Evening entertainment (music, shows)









- Souvenir medal or pin
- Other souvenirs at the discretion of the organiser.

Reg. 7 Accommodation

- 100% of the campsite booking fee (including additional nights) will be paid with the registration.
- all non-camping participants will have to directly book accommodation on their own (Note: Non-campers will not be classified).

The additional (days) campsite bookings will be made on the entry form.

The charge for additional camping nights will be **18 Euros per night/per person**, **breakfast is included**.

The amounts due for the accommodation will be paid at the same time as the registration fee, i.e. before the deadline as quoted in Reg. 5. to the bank account quoted in Reg. 4.

All payments will be in Euros (€) and will cover the transfer costs.

Reg. 8 Welcome / Administrative centre

The Welcome/Administrative Centre will be open on the following dates and times:

The entry papers, vehicles and IDs of the participants (with picture) will be checked at the Welcome Centre upon arrival.

After successful participant identification, participant "classification card", (similar to their ID card, but used for classification) will be put in the "results box" to be used for classification and results.









Reg. 9 Results and classification

According to Reg. 7 of category 1.2 of the CTG. Participants not affiliated to FMNs or their delegated bodies will not be classified. Non-camping participants will not be classified.

In case of a dispute concerning participant classification, the solution will be found according to the CTG between the FMN National Delegate and the FIM CTL Results Team members.

Classification will be closed at 12.00 on Friday **04 August 2023**. Participants arriving after this time will be eligible for the services of Motocamp but will not be included in the classification.

Reg. 10 Disqualifications

Participants shall be officially disqualified at the discretion of the Executive Committee if necessary.

Reg. 11 Prize-Giving Ceremony

According to Reg. 12 of category 1.2 of the CTG. Official FIM Motocamp awards will be delivered on the evening of the 5 August 2023. Organisers' awards for each participating nation (FMN) and clubs classification will be delivered on the evening of the 4 August 2023.

Reg. 12 National Delegates

Each participating FMN should nominate one delegate holder of a Tourism Steward's licence. The nomination shall be made in writing to the Organiser (e-mail indicated in Reg. 1.1) at least 15 days before the event. (See Art. 8 - Appendix C -CTG).

Reg. 13 Cancellation of meeting

According to Reg. 2.7 of the General Part of CTG.

The organiser can cancel the meeting:

- If, at the closing date, the number of entries is less than 100.
- In case of absolute necessity.

Should of the meeting be cancelled, the participants who transmitted their registration forms before the entry closing date, through their FMNs, will be notified and reimbursed through their FMNs.

Reg. 14 General

During the meeting of the National Delegates, the Motocamp Director will give information on the daily programs.

Every evening at the time and place of dinner, the organiser will display on a board the details of the following day's programme (place and departure time of the trips, meal times, planned events, etc.) The delegates of the FMNs are requested to collaborate in preparing a version / informing participants in their national language.

Participants agree to have their photo / video taken on public places, event venues and official events of FIM Motocamp 2023 for Organisers and FIM usage.

Cancellation of registration

- In case of individual registration cancellation, it shall be made by FMN on behalf of the participant and shall be transmitted to the Organiser
- Until 01 June 80% of the registration fee and extra accommodation and excursion will be refunded.
- Between 02 June 01 July 50% of the registration fee and extra accommodation and excursion will be refunded.
- After **01 July** no refund is possible
- In case of COVID after **01 July** 50% of the registration fee will be refunded, if documents proving the case are provided
 - Accepted cases:
 - Participating country not able to travel (documentation to be provided: country rules)
 - Participating country can't enter Lithuania (documentation to be provided: country rules)

Reg.15 Liability of the Authorities, Organisers and Participants

According to Reg. 4 of the General part of the CTG.

Reg. 16 Responsibility of the participants

Participants must respect local authority regulations and the Organisers "house-rules" during the event.

The campsite is set up on the private campsite:

- Fires are strictly prohibited within the campsite area
- Motorbikes are allowed on the grass
- Notice to smokers cigarette butts should be placed in the ashtrays provided, not on the ground.

According to Art. 4, participants not complying to event rules may be disqualified.

Reg. 17 Rider Conduct and Protection of the Environment

Participants of the FIM Motocamp are motorcyclist ambassadors for their country and are expected to consider other road users in accordance with Art. 3 of the General Part of the CTG.

Recommendations to Road Users:

- a) Individual motorcyclists should develop riding habits to ensure full integration with other types of road users.
- b) Ride safely and avoid aggressive and competitive riding.
- c) Save petrol and reduce pollution by avoiding unnecessary idling of engines.
- d) Ride politely and limit noise pollution by using your horn only in an emergency.
- e) Noise annoyance. Use a standard or another quiet exhaust system and keep audio systems at a low level.
- f) Use only routes which are open to motorcyclists.
- g) Ride like a professional by riding at a quiet and unobtrusive pace when riding in groups.
- h) Respect nature by not travelling on paths which risk being damaged beyond a point of natural recovery.
- i) Protect wildlife and its natural habitat by riding intelligently.
- j) Ensure that your used oil, tyres, batteries and other recyclable items are properly recycled.
- k) Encourage a rational use of fuel and space economy by using motorcycles instead of driving automobiles
- 1) Remember that our cities and our roads are not circuits
